

TOWN OF QUARTZSITE  
RESOLUTION TO CANVASS VOTE

RESOLUTION NO. 91-25

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF QUARTZSITE, LA PAZ COUNTY, ARIZONA, DECLARING AND ADOPTING THE RESULTS OF THE SPECIAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 5, 1991; AND ORDERING THE RECORDING OF SUCH RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Quartzsite, La Paz County, Arizona, by Resolution No. 91-12, adopted on the 17th day of June, 1991, did cause to be submitted to the qualified electors of the Town at a special election called and held in and for the Town on the 5th day of November, 1991 for the purpose of seeking permission from qualified electors to authorize the adoption of an ordinance providing for the direct election of the mayor by a vote of the people; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Quartzsite, La Paz County, Arizona by Resolution No. 91-21, adopted on the 8th day of October, 1991, did cause to be submitted to the qualified electors of the Town at a special election called and held in and for the Town on the 5th day of November, 1991 for the purpose of seeking permission from qualified electors to authorize the Town of Quartzsite to engage in the business of or services rendered by public utilities; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council did cause notice of the Special Election to be given by the Town Clerk publishing notice thereof in the Parker Pioneer newspaper as provided by law, such newspaper published in and having general circulation within said Town, which election was to be held, and the propositions to be voted upon, copy of said notice with the affidavit of publication attached thereto, being now on file and a part of the official records of the Town Council of the Town of Quartzsite; and

WHEREAS, the election returns have been presented to and have been canvassed by the Town Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Quartzsite, La Paz County, Arizona, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the total number of ballots cast at said special election, as shown by the poll lists, was 511.

SECTION 2. That the number of questioned ballots was 4, and that voters found to be ineligible were 2.

SECTION 3. That the votes cast for Proposition 200, Direct Election of the Mayor, were as follows:

YES - 392                      NO - 113

SECTION 4. That is hereby found, determined and declared of record, that Proposition 200 did receive more than one-half of the total number.

SECTION 5. That the votes cast for Proposition 300, Utility Election, were as follows:


YES - 292                      NO - 213


SECTION 6. That is hereby found, determined and declared of record, that Proposition 300 did receive more than one-half of the total number.

SECTION 7. That all orders or resolutions in conflict be and the same are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed, and that this resolution be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.


